## God's Man Has God's Mind


How to Set Your Mind on the Things of God

All Christians whether they know it or not are theologians.

- I. A Good Theologian \_\_\_\_\_ Revelation From God
  - Matthew 16:13-18 Peter the Good Theologian
    A good theologian is a man of great faith not necessarily a man of great intellect.
  - Matthew 16:21-23 Peter the Poor Theologian

A poor theologian allows human thinking to interfere with God's clear revelation.

- "For you are not setting your mind on the things of God, but on the things of man."
  - ❖ A poor theologian says "Here is what I think!"
  - ❖ A good theologian says "This is what God has said!"



## **Examples:**

- Eternal punishment
- God's sovereignty
